Dear Parents and Carers,

Just a brief reminder that it is our Key Stage 1 Sports Day on **Tuesday 20th May in the afternoon.** We are using the afternoon to have a mixture of individual track events and some team field events. The children will be participating in a variety of activities within their year group. The children are very excited and are looking forward to the afternoon. The emphasis is on enjoyment and good fun. We hope that you will be able to join us for the event. Cold refreshments will be on sale before the events start as well as during the break between individual track events and team events (1:40-1:50) - these will be on sale on the Key Stage 2 yard.

As detailed in a previous letter, Y6 children will be running their fundraising stalls for FS and KSI children and parents/carers in the afternoon. There will be opportunities to play the games whilst the Sports Day activities are running. Staff will organise when their class is going to visit the stalls as a whole group. However, parents/carers can visit themselves throughout the afternoon.

TEAMS

This year, for sports day, we are going to be splitting the whole school into four teams - **blue team**, **red team**, **green team** and **yellow team**. The children are encouraged to come in clothes that represent their team colour and will win points for their team during the track and field events. All children from FS - Y6, as well as the staff, will be part of a team, and a leaderboard will be updated throughout the day.

The children will be told what team they are in the week before sports day by their class teacher.

As the sports day is part of the curriculum, there is an expectation that all pupils will participate in all the events. Hopefully, the weather will be kind to us, and we ask parents to ensure that their child has adequate sun protection; please make sure any sun cream is applied before school. Please ensure your child has a water bottle for the day, hat and full PE kit, including coloured t-shirt for their designated team, shorts/jogging bottoms and suitable trainers. **Earrings and jewellery must be removed and long hair tied back.**

We would like to ask any spectators, adults and younger siblings to remain behind the markers if watching the competitive events. This will ensure that children are not disturbed whilst running on the track.



Entrance to School

To ensure the safety of the children, entry onto the school premises will be via the **Monteney Gate only**. Please note that there will be no access to this event via the Well Lane entrance.

These are the timings that the gate will be opened and closed:

- The Monteney gate will open at 12:30pm until 1.00pm
- It will be locked at 1.00pm until 2:45pm

Parents and carers will not be able to gain access to the school from 1.00pm until 2.45pm. If you need to leave the school premises during this time or need further assistance, a staff member wearing a luminous vest will be able to assist.
