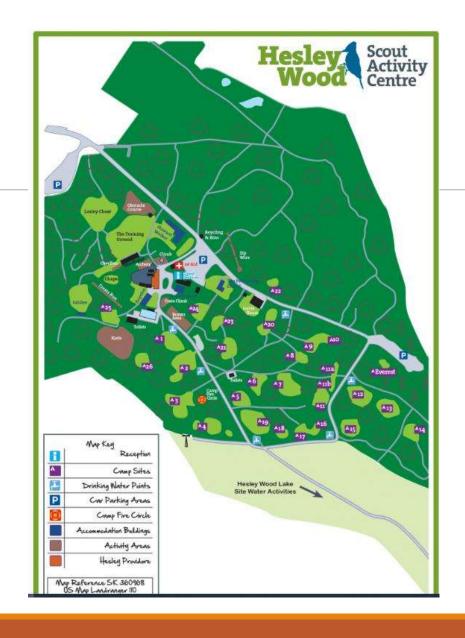

The Leatherland building has bedrooms that sleep between 4-8 children.

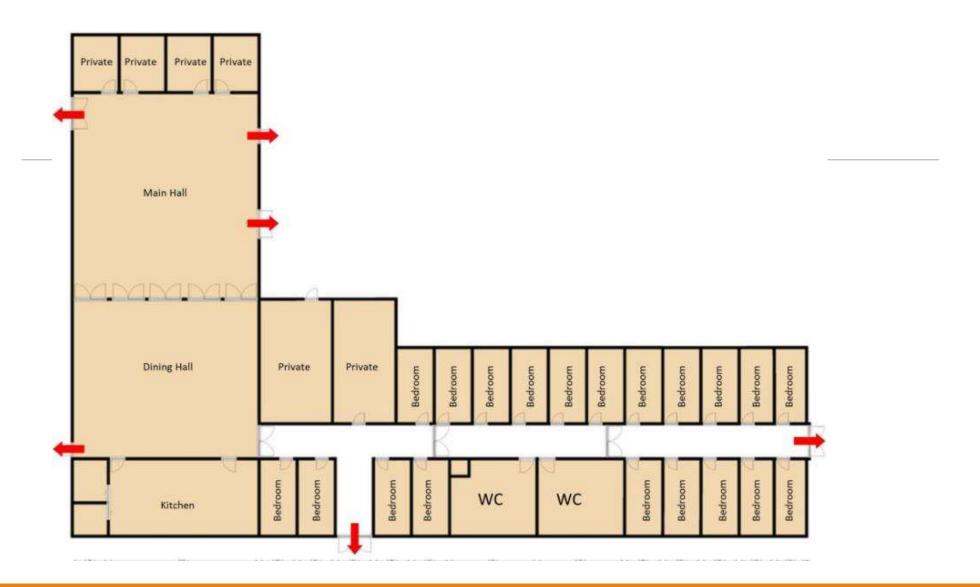

Sleeping Arrangements

Sleeping Arrangements

The Ecclesfield staff will be splitting up with 2 staff sleeping in either buildings – on the same corridors as the children.

The doors to both buildings will be locked from the inside whenever we are in there.

There are two alarmed fire exits also.
