National Emergency Services Museum Trip

Dear Parents and Carers of Year 2,

I am delighted to inform you of an up-coming visit for our Y2 class to the National Emergency Services Museum in Sheffield.

WHERE AND WHEN

Year 2 are going to visit the National Emergency Services Museum in Sheffield on Wednesday 26th February 2025.

WHY ARE WE GOING THERE?

This visit will help to support our Great Fire of London topic next half term. This topic will support our History, English and Science learning. The hands-on opportunities will facilitate the children's learning and provide a stimulating start to our new learning.

WHAT THE CHILDREN WILL DO

The workshop will be run by specialist historians from the National Services Museum and will involve interactive activities, information and the opportunity to make use of real-life objects. The workshop will take the children's imaginations back to 1666, when King Charles II was on the throne and a fire raged through London. They will understand how the fire was fought and extinguished, handle replica objects, dress up as soldiers fighting the fire and try some of the methods used. It is going to be an amazing day!
