As the festive season is fast approaching, we would like to share with you our plans for Christmas 2025.

## **DURING NOVEMBER**

# Design Your Own Christmas Card

We are delighted to be working with a local printer again this year who will be producing Christmas cards with your child's artwork design on the front of each one. Order forms will be sent home during week commencing 3rd November with an A4 space for your child to affix their drawing, colouring or painting of their Christmas design that they can create at home.

A pack of 12 cards (A6 size) are priced at £6.90 with envelopes included, and any additional packs of 12 cards are £5.00. The ParentPay offer will go live on 3rd November.

If you wish for your child to participate with this, please return the order forms to the school office and make payment for the number of packs you wish to have printed via the ParentPay offers "Christmas Cards - First Pack" and "Christmas Cards - Extra Packs" by 11.59pm on Thursday 20th November. The card designs will be collected from school on this day. The printed packs of cards should be delivered back to school during the week commencing 1st December.

We trust that your child will enjoy making their design at home, and that your friends and family like the cards too!

# Christmas Disco (Friends of Ecclesfield Primary Event)

#### FS / KSI Children

The FS/KSI children (FS, YI and Y2) will be having a Christmas Disco from 2.00pm until 3.00pm. Tickets are priced at £2.50 per child and can be purchased on the ParentPay offer entitled "FS KSI Disco" with a deadline of II.59pm on Tuesday 2nd December. This offer goes live at 6.00pm on Monday 20th October. Children should bring their disco outfit to school on the day in a named bag so that they can get changed before the event. Children will need to be collected from their classroom at 3.00pm. Those pupils who do not wish to attend the disco will take in part in activities within the classroom.

#### Y3 / Y4 Children

The Y3/Y4 disco will run from 3.15pm to 4.30pm. There will be a cost of £2.95 per child. Only children who have purchased a ticket will be able to attend this event. Children not attending the disco need to be collected at 3.10pm as usual.

Children attending the disco should bring their disco outfit to school in a named bag so that they can get changed before the event. They will then be taken to the disco at 3.15pm by Ecclesfield Primary staff and will need to be collected at 4.30pm from outside the front office.

Payments can be made using the "Y3 Y4 Disco" ParentPay offer by 11.59pm on Tuesday 2nd December. This offer goes live at 6.00pm on Monday 20th October.

#### Y5 / Y6 Children

The Y5/Y6 disco will run from 4.45pm to 6.00pm. There will be a cost of £2.95 per child. Only children who have purchased a ticket will be able to attend. Payments can be made via ParentPay using the "Y5 Y6 Disco" offer by 11.59pm on Tuesday 2nd December. This offer goes live at 6.00pm on Monday 20th October. Y5 and Y6 tickets will be sent home on Wednesday 3rd December. Children will need to bring their tickets to be allowed entry to the disco.

Y5 and Y6 children will not be permitted to walk home by themselves so they will need to be collected by an adult. Children should be collected promptly at 6.00pm from outside the front office.

At all three events, there will be stalls set up for the children to purchase different items including food, snacks, drinks and more. Children can bring in money to spend, but this will need to be in a named purse or wallet. The children will be responsible for their own money. Items will cost no more than £1.00 each. There will also be a tattoo stall where children can have 3 tattoos for £1.00. Children will need permission via ParentPay to be able to have their tattoos. Payment for this will be made during the disco with the money in their purse.

If any parents and carers would like to volunteer their time to support at any of the discos, then please indicate this on the relevant ParentPay offer at the same time as purchasing the ticket.

# FS-Y3 Christmas Snow Globe Workshop

We are holding a special Christmas workshop with children from all year groups invited to take part. On 10th December, children will have the opportunity to make their very own Christmas Snow Globe. The children will learn about different materials and techniques to develop



their imagination and creative thinking. They will produce a unique decoration which can take pride of place in the family home every Christmas. The cost of the workshop is  $\pounds 2.95$  per child.

The workshop will be set up as a mobile studio in the large hall, and all the materials and equipment will be provided to the children to create their masterpiece.

Unfortunately, due to time constraints, we cannot offer this workshop to all classes currently as there are only 240 places available. Once these places have been filled, there will be no opportunity for other children to attend so we would advise securing a place via ParentPay as soon as possible. The workshops will be held throughout the day, and it will be open to parents and carers to come and join the children. If you would like your child to participate, please complete the ParentPay offer entitled "Snow Globe Workshop" by 11.59pm on Friday 28th November.

A timetable will be sent out closer to the time to inform you of when your child's class will be participating in the workshop should you wish to attend. There will be no additional cost for any parents attending.
