From September, we will be offering individual and paired lessons in guitar, keyboard, ukulele, drums and singing. The school has also invested in a brand-new set of instruments for pupils to use during their lessons as well as a new music room dedicated to these lessons.

Ready to rock!

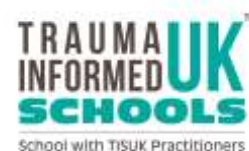
We will continue to offer rock band sessions, where pupils will work in groups of 5–6, playing guitar, keyboards, bass guitar, drums and vocals. A Harmony band leader will guide each group through popular songs, helping to develop teamwork, confidence and collaboration. Each term will culminate in a concert for pupils and parents to enjoy.

Please note: where possible, we will endeavour to keep all existing Rocksteady band line-ups the same, so pupils can continue learning together.



Pupil Premium

If your child is eligible for Pupil Premium/free school meals, we are pleased to offer reduced prices for paired instrument lessons and rock band sessions. These prices are in purple on the pricing tables.



Lessons are available for children of all ages from FS to Y6 and instruments are provided by school. If your child has their own instrument, they are more than welcome to bring it to their lesson!

Instrument lessons



Instruments are taught either 1:1 or 2:1 with an experienced teacher and children will be taught how to play in different styles and genres, from blues to rock and soul to jazz. With **regular training and development**, Harmony's fully DBS checked teachers will offer the very best lessons possible.

Instrument lessons are available on guitar, keyboard, ukulele, drums and singing and are to be paid per half term in advance.

Rock Band Sessions



In these group sessions of 5-6 pupils, children will form bands based on instrument preferences and learn about band dynamics and teamwork in band rehearsals with a focus on building self-confidence and expression. They will learn popular songs and perform a concert at the end of each term!

Rock band instrument lessons are available on guitar, keyboard, bass guitar, drums and singing and are to be paid per half term in advance.
