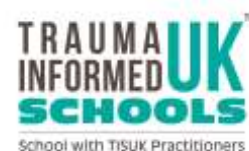
Y6 Thornbridge Outdoors Residential Monday 13th July 2026 - Wednesday 15th July 2026

Dear Parents and Carers,

After positive feedback, we would like to offer our Year 6 pupils the opportunity to take part in a 2 night (3 day) residential experience in July 2026 at Thornbridge Outdoors. The benefits of a residential visit include building team working skills, developing confidence staying away from home and building independence skills to name a few. It has always been such a great experience for the children in the past and the children have taken many special memories from the visit.

The cost of the visit last year was £238. We will aim to keep as close to this price as possible, but as we all know, prices have been increasing recently, we are anticipating that the cost of the visit will be slightly higher. The cost will include the coach, food and instructor-led activities for all of the sessions the children take part in. We require a non-refundable deposit of **£30 per child** to confirm their place on the trip. The deadline for this deposit, payable via the **ParentPay** offer entitled "**Thornbridge Deposit**" is **11.59pm on Friday 9th January 2026**. When we have our final numbers from this, we will be able to confirm the final cost.

We have set up a **ParentPay** offer so that you can start to pay for the visit in instalments prior to the announcement of the final amount, if you wish to do so. Please use the **ParentPay** offer entitled "**Thornbridge 2026 Payments**" which allows you to make up to 6 payments of £25.00.



The deadline for the final payment will be **11.59pm on Monday 4th May 2026**. As mentioned previously, as soon as we have final number we can confirm the final cost. If you have any further questions, please feel free to contact us via the office.
