



How do I report my child's absence?

Absences should be reported to school via telephone (0114 2467396 - option I for the attendance team) or using the absence text system via the School Gateway app (the speech bubble icon) by 9.00am or as soon as practically possible. Telephone lines open daily at 8.00am.

Please do **not** notify school of absences via **Class Dojo** or year group email as these are not constantly monitored.

Formal Request for Exceptional Leave Forms must be completed for all planned absences (such as holidays).
