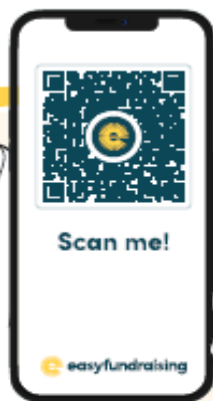
Well done to all this week's Merit Award Winners!

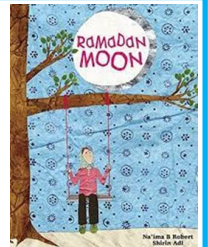
Book of the Week

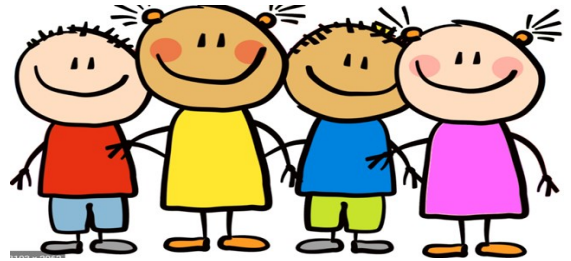
School Attendance Matters @ Ecclesfield Primary

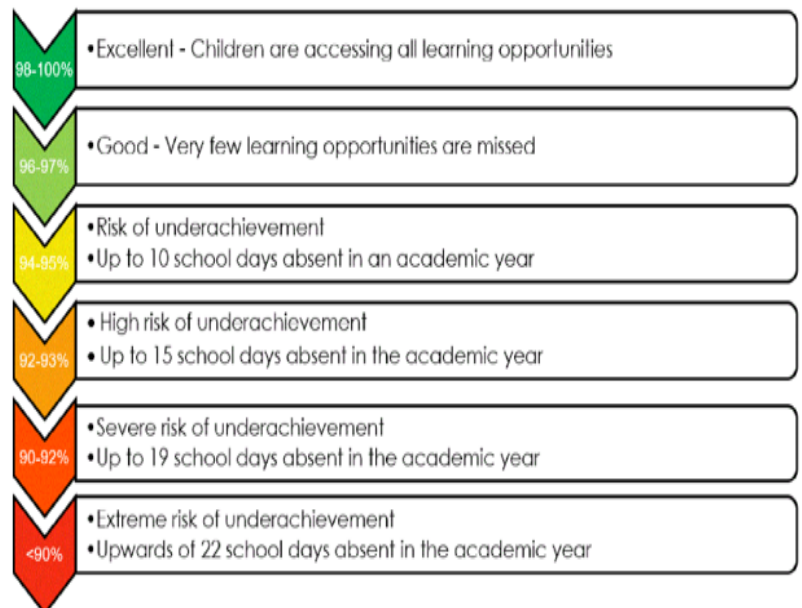

Punctuality

Punctuality is extremely important so that your child has a good start to the school day. At registration time, the teachers share the plans for the day ahead and learning begins straight away.
