

Punctuality

Punctuality is extremely important so that your child has a good start to the day. At registration time, the teachers share the plans for the day ahead and deal with any issues. If a child is not in school on time they will not know what is going to happen during the day and will also be late starting their morning tasks

	Extreme risk of underachievement Upwards of 22 school days absent in the academic year
